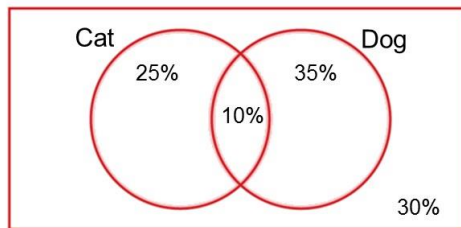




A different group are asked the same question.
